#### **Mission Statement**

## **Philosophy of Education**

Community Christian School believes in the following scriptures and principles:

SPIRITUAL SALVATION, GROWTH, AND DEVELOPMENT – Humanity's only hope of salvation is through the sacrifice of Jesus Christ at Calvary (Romans 3:23, 6:23, 5:8, and 5:1; Ephesians 2:8,9). A study of the character of God leads the student to an understanding of his purpose for life and resulting responsibilities which are his as a Biblically-centered Christian (Ephesians 4:12).

**SHARED HOME/SCHOOL/ RESPONSIBILITY** – The parents have prime responsibility for their child's education. Therefor, a close home/school relationship is vital. Open channels of communication are extremely important for the total well-being of the student. (See Parent/Student Handbook for additional information.)

**ACADEMIC DEVELOPEMENT** – Proverbs 2:1-7 is our basis for instruction. We are to stress: 1) wisdom, 2) understanding, and 3) knowledge in the order God as designed. Attention to the fundamental subjects is presented through a Christ-cnetered academic curriculum. Cultural appreciation and patriotism are integral parts of the academic program. Bible is taught every day.

**SOCIAL DEVELOPEMENT** – Social development is a highly significant aspect of education. Relationships are the foundation for effective Christian modeling, and, as such, are exemplified by Christian teachers. Christ-centered values are taught as the reference point for personal decision-making.

**PHYSICAL DEVELOPEMENT** – Proper body care and development are emphasized in I Corinthians 3:16, 6:19-20. Each student is led to an appreciation of the value of his/her body and its care as a "temple holy unto God."

#### **Statement of Faith**

**We believe** the Bible to be the only inspired, infallible, authoritative, inherent Word of God. (II Timothy 3:15, II Peter 1:21.)

**We believe** there is only one God, eternally existent in three persons – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. (Genesis 1:1, Matthew 28:19, John 10:30).

**We believe** in the deity of Christ (John 10:33): His virgin birth (Isaiah 7:14, Matthew 1:23, Luke 1:35); His sinless life (Hebrews 4:15, 7:26); His miracles (John 2:11); His vicarious and atoning death (I Corinthians 15:3, Ephesians 1:7, Hebrews 2:9); His resurrection (John 11:25, I Corinthians 15:4), His ascension to the right hand of the Father (Mark 16:19); His personal return in power and glory (Acts 1:11, Revelations 19:11).

**We believe** in the absolute necessity of regeneration by the Holy Spirit for salvation because of the exceeding sinfulness of human nature, that men are justified on the single ground of faith in the shed blood of Christ, and that only by God's grace and through faith we are saved (John 3:16-19, 5:24, Romans 3:23, 5:8-9, Ephesians 2:8-10, Titus 3:5).

**We believe** in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost; that they are saved unto the resurrection of life and that they are lost unto the resurrection of damnation (John 5:28-29).

**We believe** in the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus Christ (Romans 8:9, I Corinthians 12:12-13, Galatians 3:26-28).

We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a godly life (Romans 8:13-14, I Corinthians 3:16, 6:19-20, Ephesians 4:30).
